### Competitions Rules for Club Medals and Stablefords

Dear Alan,

From Friday the 3rd July the following procedures will be in place for Club Medal and Stableford competitions. The Senior's and Ladies sections may vary. The Local rules are in place for ALL COMPETITIONS

#### HOW TO ENTER COMPETITION

Book your own tee times as four balls. For member reserved block tee times, please have all names on the tee sheet 48 hours before the competition date. Any unreserved tee time will be released 48hrs before the competition.

#### ENTERING COMPETITION AND PAYMENT

You can only Enter on the day via the HOW DID I DO APP or HOW DID I DO WEB BROWSER at home. Please click on the Today's Golf section. This must be done before teeing off. Entry fee of £3 and optional £2 2' s Competition Entry fees will be paid from your Member Card Credit when you sign in on HOW DID I DO.

(Please note you will not be able to enter in the shop)

#### ENTERING SCORES VIA HOW DID I DO

After your round please enter your scores via the HOW DID I DO APP or HOW DID I DO WEB BROWSER at home. Please take your score card home with you. (THE CLUB MAY REQUEST FOR WINNING GOLFERS SCORECARDS TO BE SENT VIA EMAIL)

(Please note you can only enter your own scores via How did I do)

All medals and stablefords will be qualifying competitions from the White Tees for Men and Red tees for Ladies

#### COMPETITIONS

All competition winnings and 2' s winnings will be added to your members card.

#### LOCAL RULES CONCERNING PLAY DURING COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

The following Local Rules are compliant with England Golf and R&A guidelines and satisfy CONGU regulations for Qualifying and Supplementary Scores handicap from the 12th June,

#### BUNKERS

All bunkers will be in play. No rakes will be in the bunkers and players are requested to smooth the sand using their feet and club after playing their shots. Preferred lies are available in bunkers under the following local rule.

When a player's ball lies in a bunker the player may take free relief once by placing a ball within 6" of the original lie, in the bunker and no nearer the hole.

The area must NOT be smoothed before placing.

See rule 14.2b(2) and 14.2e for the procedure to be used.

Penalty for playing ball from a wrong place in breach of local rule. General penalty under Rule 14.7a

#### ON THE PUTTING GREEN

##### 1. The Flagstick

Players are required to leave the flagstick in the hole at all times and not to touch or remove it.

Players MUST NOT deliberately touch or remove the flagstick at any time. If a flagstick is not correctly centered it may be moved into place by some means other than touching with the hand, eg using a putter head or elbow.

Penalty for breach of this Local Rule: General Penalty

#### MARKING THE SCORE CARD

Both players should mark the scores and scores should be verified after each hole and at the end of the round.

Do not swap scorecards at the end of the round.
